

Childhood Immunizations

2010 QARR Requirements for Children Born in 2008

For children to be fully immunized, and your practice to be in full compliance, all the following vaccines must be administered by the 2nd birthday.

Vaccines	Time Requirements	CPT Codes
4 DTaP	Minimum age: 42 days	90698, 90700, 90721, 90723
3 IPV	Minimum age: 42 days	90698, 90713, 90723
1 MMR	None	90707, 90710
3 HIB	Minimum age: 42 days	90645-90648, 90698, 90721, 90748
3 Hepatitis B	None	90723, 90740, 90744, 90747, 90748
1 Varicella (VZV)	None	90710, 90716
4 Pneumococcal Conjugate	Minimum age: 42 days	90669
2 Hepatitis A	None	90633
2 Influenza	Minimum age: 6 months	90655, 90657
2 or 3 Rotavirus	Minimum age: 42 days	2 doses – 90681 3 doses – 90680

Citywide Immunization Registry Reporting (CIR)

It is mandatory in the 5 boroughs to report immunization administration to the CIR. Are you in compliance with that mandate?

Health care providers in Manhattan, Bronx, Queens, Brooklyn and Staten Island electronically report immunizations to the CIR by:

- Using the Online Registry, <http://www.nyc.gov/html/doh/html/cir/index.html> or
- Sending electronic files extracted from encounter, billing or clinical management information systems
- The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene now offers free training for all health care providers on how to access the Online Registry. To arrange for training at your office, call (212) 676-2323.

New York State Immunization Information System (NYSIIS)

As of January 1, 2008, health care providers in New York State are required to report all immunizations administered to persons less than 19 years of age to the New York State Department of Health. Immunizations must be entered within 14 days of administration. (New York City providers will continue to report to the CIR, not the NYSIIS.)

How to report to the NYSIIS:

- Providers report immunizations through the Health Provider Network (HPN) of the NYSDOH Health Commerce System.
- Each NYSIIS user must have an individual HPN account.
